10/24/2022	Ready to eat, potentially hazardous food shall be discarded if they are beyond their discard date.  Observed several ready to eat, potentially hazardous foods beyond their discard date such as multiple Portable Protein Packs (9/5//22) and Kramer Farms Hard Boiled eggs (10/19/22).  CORRECTED AT TIME OF INSPECTION: PIC discarded the expired products and states an intent to emphasize training and practice of evaluating discard dates during the restocking process.
