



University of Michigan Face Covering Policy for COVID-19
Effective April 7, 2023

Masks are optional for most indoor spaces on the University of Michigan campuses. Certain units, such as Michigan Medicine, University Health Service, and the School of Dentistry, have local-level policies requiring masks under certain conditions. Individuals who have tested positive or have been exposed to COVID-19 should mask while around others through Day 10 of their isolation or self-monitoring period.

Mask use is still suggested as an effective strategy for enhanced personal protection, especially for those with compromised immune status, those who are not vaccinated or up to date on their COVID-19 vaccinations, and anyone with a perceived increased situational risk.
