ADDRESSED/CORRECTED DURING ROUTINE INSPECTION - Bagged soup waste was discarded. I discussed with student staff the importance of using hand washing sinks only for hand washing purposes and ensuring that hand washing sinks remain easily accessible at all times to encourage employee hand washing.
