Observed inoperable multi-step water filtration system on the back wall of the storage room. Filters were labeled with a last replacement date of November 2024. Removing this non-functional plumbing is necessary for the safety and quality of the building's water supply.

Correct as soon as possible by removing broken/nonfunctioning equipment items that are no longer in use throughout the establishment.

Excellent food safety protocols in place by staff. Confirm if cleaning responsibility of shared Starbucks/Siege walk-in cooler falls to Starbucks or Siege employees.
