

Biological Exposure Response

Call 911 for any Life Threatening Emergency

1

Perform First Aid

Sharps Injury or Animal Bite/Scratch

Expose wound, remove PPE, wash with soap and water, then cover

Mucous Membrane or Splash Exposure

Nose, mouth, skin: rinse with water for 15 min
Eyes: flush with water / saline for 15 min
