

Gloves for Animal Bite Prevention

While not a replacement for proper handling and restraint techniques, EHS recommends wearing bite/cut resistant gloves to provide extra protection against bites and scratches during handling animals procedures.

Many of the gloves are designed to be worn under the required nitrile/latex gloves required for animal handling.
