

University of Michigan Vaccination Policy - Ann Arbor/Marygrove Michigan Housing

Updated June 11, 2025

All U-M students residing in Michigan Housing on the Ann Arbor and Marygrove campuses are required to submit their vaccination records. These records should include information about any vaccine doses the student has received for the following:

- Measles, mumps, rubella (MMR)
- Meningococcal disease (MenACWY)
- Meningitis B
- Polio
- Tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella (Chickenpox)

U-M students who are not vaccinated against these diseases are still required to complete the vaccination submission form, which includes an option to attest that they are not vaccinated. This attestation acknowledges they may be subject to additional public health protocols should there be a public health need. Students who submit an attestation without vaccination records may be asked to provide additional information.

The requirements in this policy are in addition to other vaccination requirements that may be applicable to faculty, staff and students by their school, college, unit or third-party partners.
